World Newspaper Archive Latin American Newspapers, Part II

Provisional Title List
(as of October 2011)

The Center for Research Libraries, in partnership with Readex (a division of NewsBank), plans to launch a new module of the World Newspaper Archive named “**Latin American Newspapers, part II.**”

The first module of LAN produced more than 1.2 million pages of newspapers produced in Mexico, Central and South America, and the Caribbean. Guided by our advisory and selection committees, the newest module, **LAN II**, will complement that collection by deepening coverage of important countries such as Argentina, Brazil, Chile, Cuba, and Mexico; and by extending the reach of WNA into countries not represented in LAN I such as Bolivia, El Salvador, Nicaragua, Costa Rica and Belize.

This second Latin American module will be of equal size to the first, covering the same time period (spanning 1822-1922). Combined, these two collections will provide unparalleled coverage of events of the 19th and early 20th century in Latin America. Content is selected from the collections of partner libraries such as the University of Florida, University of Texas at Austin, Berkeley, Yale, and New York Public Library.
