Phase 4B

Work continues on assigning retention commitments for approximately 9,000 Statistics Canada publications. This phase involves a mix of monographs and serials. The assignments are slated to be complete this spring.

Phase 5

Planning for this phase was delayed somewhat through 2018. This phase involves identifying and securing 500 rare or at-risk Western Canadian serials. This phase is intended to start as soon as Phase 4B ends.

Canadian Collaborative Print Stewardship Working Group

The CCPS Working Group is a joint effort of the Canadian Association of Research Libraries (CARL/ABRC) and Library and Archives Canada (LAC/BAC). It includes representatives of library consortia and shared print initiatives from across Canada. The group is exploring the means by which we might be able to develop a national approach to shared print stewardship. Working group members have drafted a terms of reference. There will be a working day in Toronto in early February.

A sub-group of CCPS is working with OCLC to conduct an overlap study, using Greenglass, of Canadian federal government documents held at 36 government, academic and public libraries. Much of the work is anticipated to occur in spring 2019.
