A Quick Word about the CIC

- ◆ **CIC is big**

 - 15 research schools

 - 100 million+ library volumes

- ◆ **CIC is established**

 - working together since 1958

- ◆ **CIC is like-minded**

 - similar collections = lots of duplication

CIC Shared Print Repository

- ◆ Collocated shared print storage
- ◆ STEM journals with widespread e-access (for now)
- ◆ Overseen by Steering Committee, aided by Working Groups
- ◆ First site at Indiana University
- ◆ Ohio State U supplied first trans-state shipment

Custodians of the State

Physical location transfers

but

depositor retains ownership.

- ◆ State property stays in state's ownership

AKA “Here, Hold This For Me”

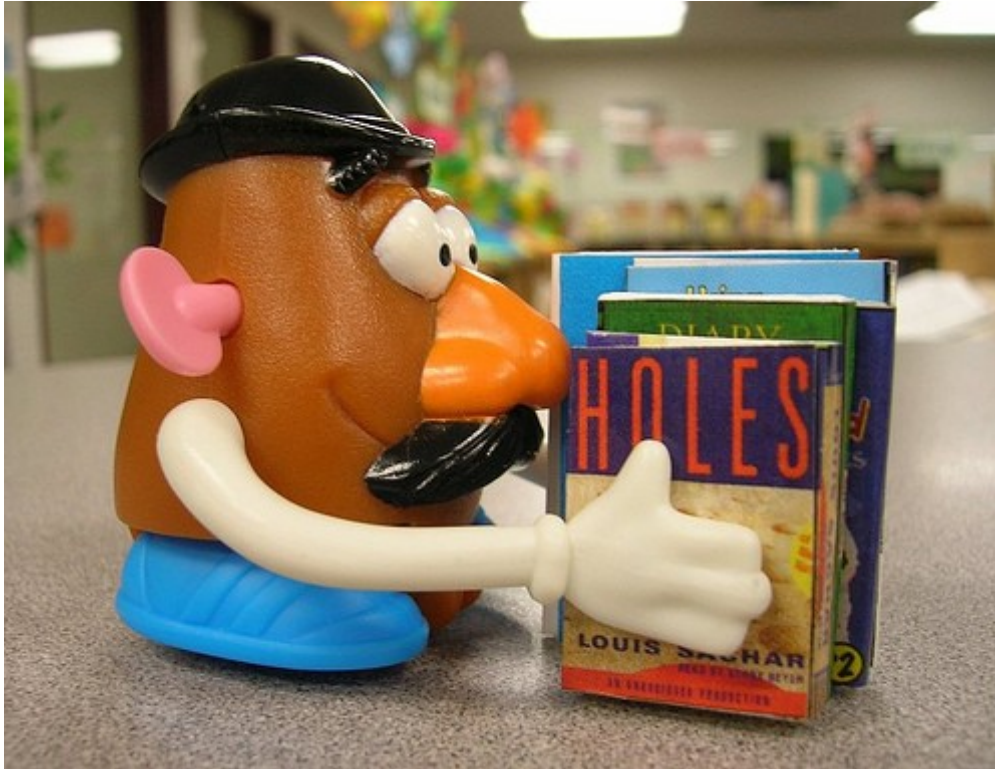

The Official Language

DEPOSITING LIBRARIES will **retain ownership** of materials designated for the CIC SHARED PRINT REPOSITORY, but will **cede ongoing administrative control** of the content to the one or more HOST SITE(S) storing materials on its behalf.

Why Collocate?

- ◆ Pooling resources benefits more libraries
- ◆ Allows all to participate
- ◆ Ensures preservation-quality storage
- ◆ Builds long-term commitment to shared project

How Collocation Is Possible

- ◆ Provost-level support from beginning
- ◆ Stable, longstanding consortium
- ◆ Right timing

How Collocating Works

- ◆ LHRs must reflect current location and originating info

How Inter-state Storage Works

- ◆ Flexibility within standards
- ◆ Host institutions must collaborate in some decision-making
- ◆ Materials have to be shipped, possibly multiple times
- ◆ Requires confidence and trust in partners to be good stewards
