SHARED PRINT REGISTRATION

Registration Benefits

- A streamlined registration process that:
 - Allows batch creation of Shared Print monograph retention commitments
 - Uses non-MARC data to create LHRs via a 583 Action Note
 - Eliminates the need for an OCLC second symbol for “shared print in place” monograph collections
 - Sets the Shared Print holding type flag in the WorldCat bib record which enables visibility into Discovery/Access
 - Provides ability to output MARC records in multiple formats, including non-interleaved LHRs, for input into ILS

Registration Process – Upload File

- Excel file consisting of:
 - OCLC Number
 - Local System Record Number
 - Barcode (WorldShare Management Services libraries only)
- Uploaded through MyFiles

Registration Process – Data Input

- Online Template with minimal data:
 - Retention Commitment
 - Archiving Program Name
 - Retention Period
 - ILL Policy (Lending/Reproduction)
 - Current Location of Archived Item
 - Linkage Information
 - Ownership History (optional)
