Working discussions focusing on areas discussed the previous day:

***Economic and Legal Strategies: Engaging the Publishers*** (Bernard Reilly, convener)

Discussion will explore potential interactions with publishers that might enable CRL and LC to better exploit and disseminate scholarly content:

- 1) Support for in-region electronic publication of critical knowledge through cooperative investment by LC, CRL, and North American partner libraries;
- 2) Securing from publishers uniform, minimum digital rights to preserve traditional and electronic source materials;
- 3) Co-investment with publishers in the cooperative digitization of developing-world materials held by North American libraries.

***Developing Capacities in the Regions*** (James Simon, convener)

Discussion will explore the approaches, tools, and costs of developing partnerships and means of accessing new research material in emerging area:

- 1) cooperation with the Library of Congress field offices in acquiring resources and developing international collaborations;
- 2) training and providing resources for in-region preservation and digitization of content;
- 3) exploring document delivery with regional partners.

***Capturing and Harvesting Web-based Materials*** (Elizabeth Darocha Berenz, convener)

Discussion will survey the needs and desires of participants in capturing Web-based and other born digital resources, assess extant models and costs, and explore possibilities for cross-regional activity.
