## **GreenGlass Enhancements since 2013**



- Inclusion of LC Class and Dewey 1s in exported lists
- Integration of Committed/Registered Retentions throughout GreenGlass\*






## **U.S. Shared Print Retentions by State**








## **Shared Print Retentions by Group**








# Shared Print Monograph Retentions in North America

#### Search the Shared Print Collection

Most shared print initiatives have focused first on retention of titles scarcely held in the country, region, state or group. This strategy assures that the titles most at risk are secured first. The context of holdings in other libraries provided by WorldCat informs these decisions, and helps prioritize each group's work.

Increasingly, it will be important to know, for a given title, what retention commitments are in place. While much of this work will be done in batches or programmatically, OCLC SCS recognize that collection strategists may benefit from the ability to explore the collective shared print collection interactively. The search box below demonstrates one such possibility. You can use it to explore the sample collection. Below each title is a color-coded list of the programs that have committed to retain that title.

## **Shared Print Registration: Monographs**

- Imminent release at OCLC
  - Software development complete
  - Pilot groups in progress (WRLC, CI-CCI)
  - Fully available early 2018
- Goals:
  - make the committed collective collection visible
  - Improve subsequent rounds of analysis
  - Operationalize the collective collection via discovery
     & resource sharing




## **Rethinking Group Projects**






