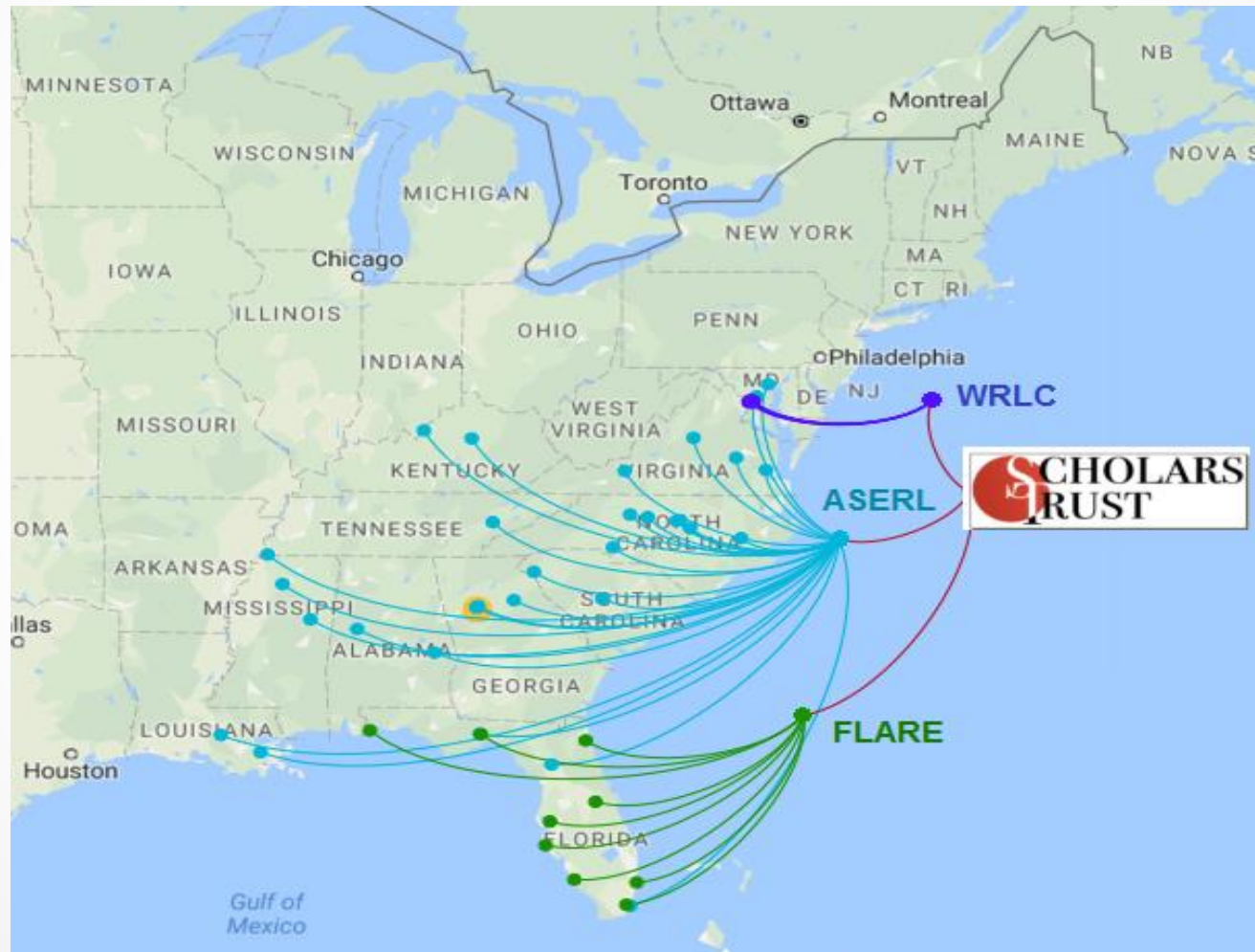

# Disclosure

- Retention commitments are recorded in the Marc 583 per OCLC Metadata Guidelines for Shared Print
  - Scholars Trust libraries chose not to adopt a common Shared Print Symbol.
- Quarterly update to the PAPR registry.

# Disclosure

- Journal Retention & Needs Listing [JRNL]
  - ASERL, WRLC, FLARE, TRLN, WEST, BTAA
  - 35,136 Titles (73% are single copy, 15% have a second commitment)
- Title list maintained on the Scholars Trust website [XLS].

# Resource Sharing

- January 2013 – Reciprocal ILL Agreement
  - Revised in December 2016 -  
<https://scholarstrust.org/resource-sharing>
- Loosely structured, with no formal governance.
  - The Interlibrary Loan Code for the United States.
  - OCLC GAC (Group Access Capability) - ASRL
- Priority service
  - Good faith effort to begin processing requests within 24 hours of receipt and to ship within 2 days.
- No ILL fees, no overdue fines, and no postage fees.

# Resource Sharing

- Items loaned for a minimum of 8 weeks.
- Borrowing/Lending not limited to Scholars Trust retained titles.
- No performance measures.
  - Statistical Reports
    - 171,720 Loans in FY2017 ↓ 8%
    - 185,237 Loans in FY2016 ↓ 5%
    - 194,441 Loans in FY2015
