RESHARE : Mission

Develop and support a library resource sharing community and open source software that fosters innovation and focuses on user needs.

RESHARE : Priorities

In our ideal world, ReShare will:

1. Decouple discovery (what's available) and delivery (fulfillment)
2. Minimize barriers between consortia and systems
3. Put the patron in the center of every transaction
4. Allow for maximum interoperability
5. Create library/community-owned infrastructure

**Your organization should not bend to the app,
the applications should be flexible enough to fit your organization.**

ReShare is a peer to peer system
(with optional shared index)





: Opportunities for Supporting Shared Print

- Partnered with Colorado Alliance/Gold Rush, using a similar algorithm for content comparison and holdings/items display in shared index
 - ReShare could be used to further support Gold Rush collection analysis across disparate ILS/LSP systems from a single shared index environment
- Connections between ReShare nodes and across consortia could expand access to holdings information
- Shared index holdings field exists for retention commitments and represents a big opportunity for shared print!
