



"In the most straightforward analysis, CRL's activities are transformative . . . CRL serves a new and different audience from the ones to which the serials, public information, and ephemera in its collections originally were addressed." "... The documentary and informational character of the copyright material that CRL distributes on line clearly favors a finding of fair use."

"Summing up, it is my opinion that application of the broadly accepted consensus approach to fair use analysis in today's federal courts would arrive without difficulty at the conclusion that CRL's digitization and targeted document delivery activities fall categorically within the scope of the fair use doctrine." Research and Development Tier I funding

- Partial support of the planning phase
- An effort to mine the bibliographic and other records produced by major humanities preservation microfilming programs and digitization efforts
- Data to inform library decision-making on the management of print today.

Latin American Materials Project (LAMP)

- Founded in 1975 to "preserve materials in danger of being lost or becoming inaccessible"
- Preserved many newspapers, serials, archives, government publications
- Aggregated expertise and funds to preserve content
- Pilot Project: Brazilian Government

Global Collections Initiative

Aims to:

- Expand electronic access to materials
- Forge international partnerships at the national level to support increased access
- Focus on Latin America & Caribbean in the pilot phase, expanding to other regions in coming years



Global Collections Initiative

Three streams of activity:

- Digitization of existing library collections
- Collective dealings with publishers, for licensing and access to additional content
- Evaluation of web harvesting and alternatives








LLMC Digitization







- University-wide digital access to WSJ.com
- Includes tablet apps, WSJ+ membership
- Access to articles dating back to January 1, 1997
- 90-day archive of the print paper in digital e-reader format
- On-campus support workshops, presentations, promotion assets
- Rates based on University enrollment (FTE)
- Existing contracts eligible for CRL rates on renewal

- Full-image and full text creation
- Rollout in "packages" grouped by language / geographic area
