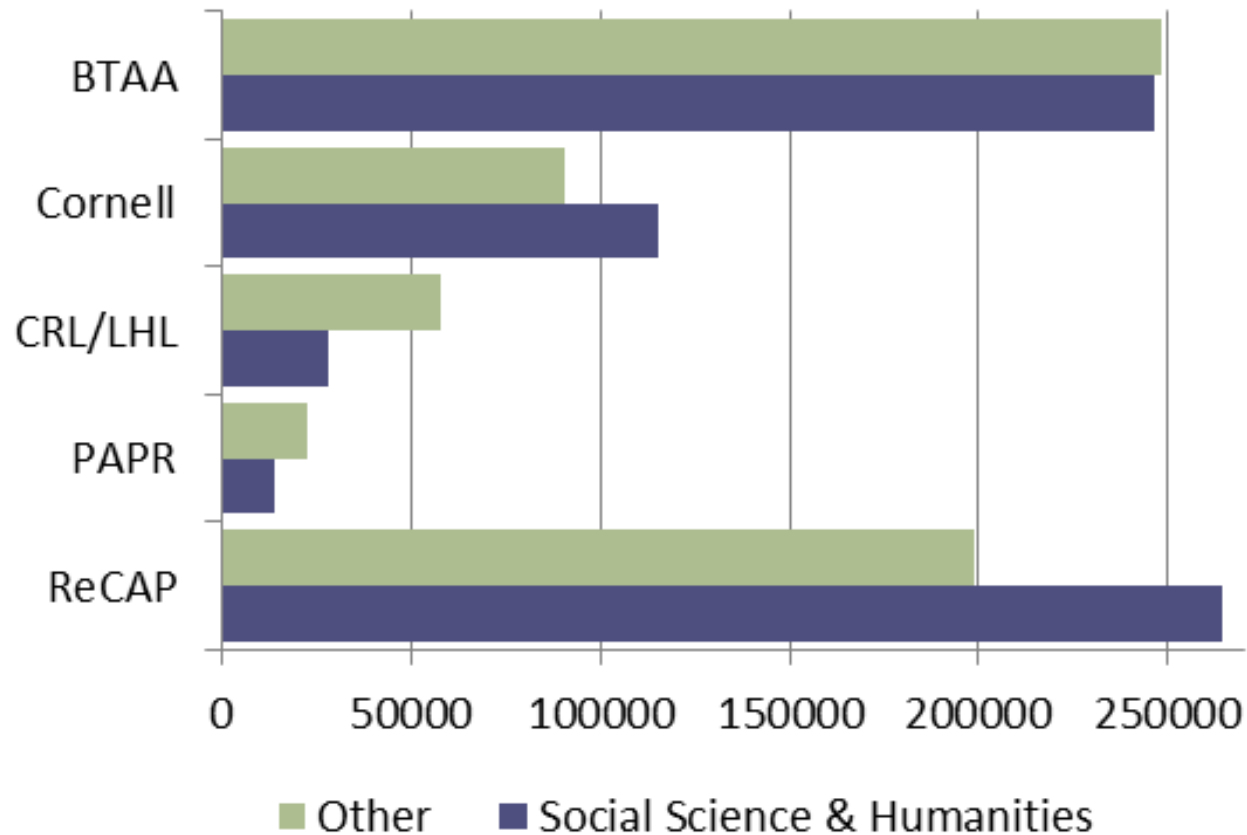

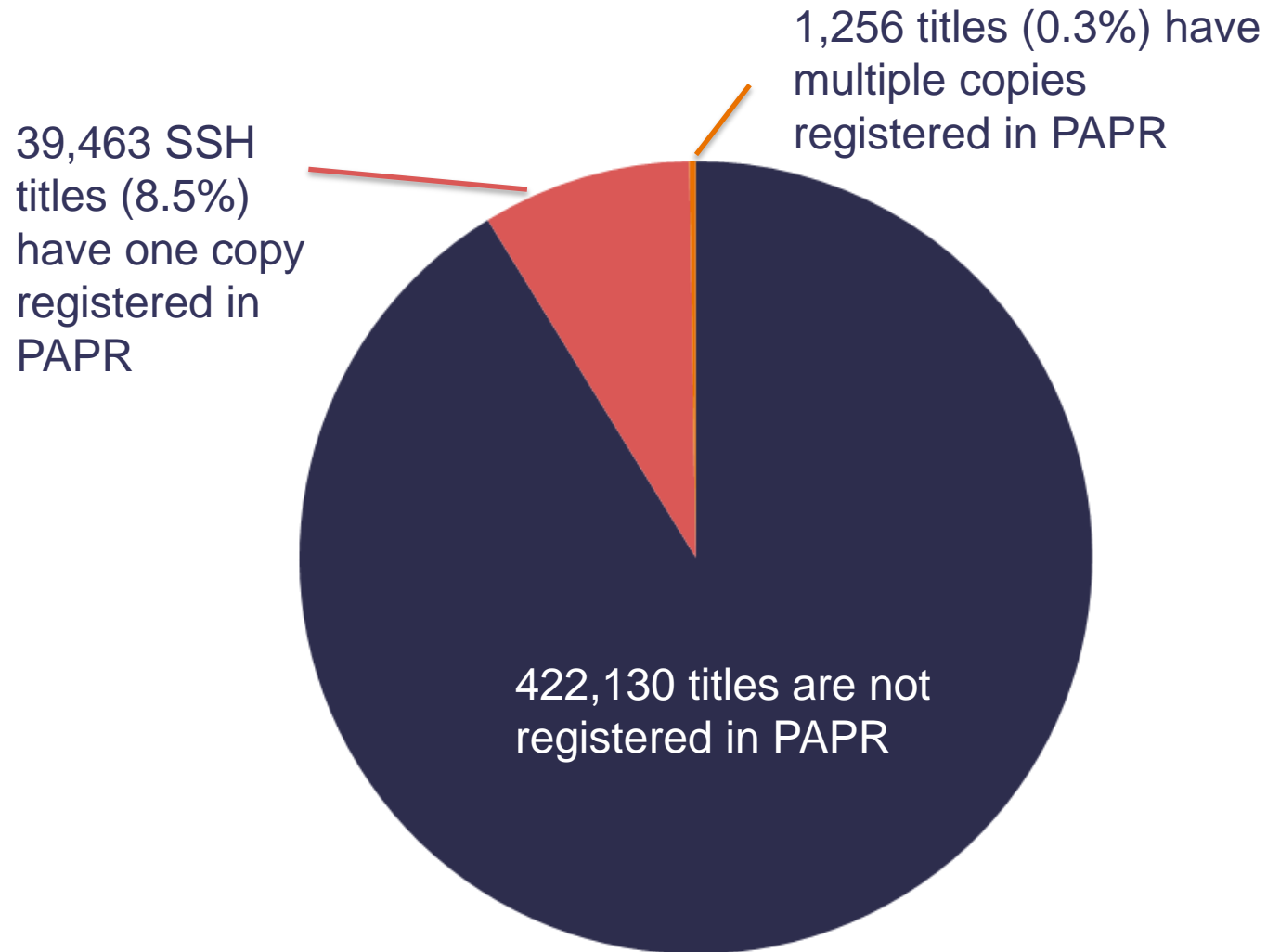

The Louis J. Boeri and Minin Bujones Boeri Collection of Cuban-American Radionovelas, 1963-1970

Description

From his office and studios on the fifth floor of "The Freedom Tower" in Miami, Italian-American Louis J. Boeri, United States government, to 200 radio stations in Latin America and Spain, and to Spanish-language radio stations and Mexican writers as well. America's Productions, Inc. produced two types of entertainment radio program entertainment programming was designed for both U.S. Latino and Latin American audiences and the content.

The Louis J. Boeri and Minin Bujones Boeri Collection of Cuban-American Radionovelas, 1963-1970 provides a American Library, the vast majority of which falls within the radionovela genre. In 2016, the Latin American Re generously funded a pilot project to digitize eight titles from the extant master audio recordings created by AI first time since they originally aired in the late 1960s. Along with the radionovelas recordings themselves, the program and brief storyline descriptions, ephemera, and photographs of the actors, actresses, writers, and producers.

The digital version of the Louis J. Boeri and Minin Bujones Boeri Collection of Cuban-American Radionovelas is available and Cuba via public broadcasting during a pivotal moment in the 20th century. The collection offers new perspectives on the Cold War era, as well as the history of popular culture and mass media in the wake of the 1959 Cuban Revolution were exported.

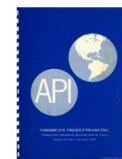

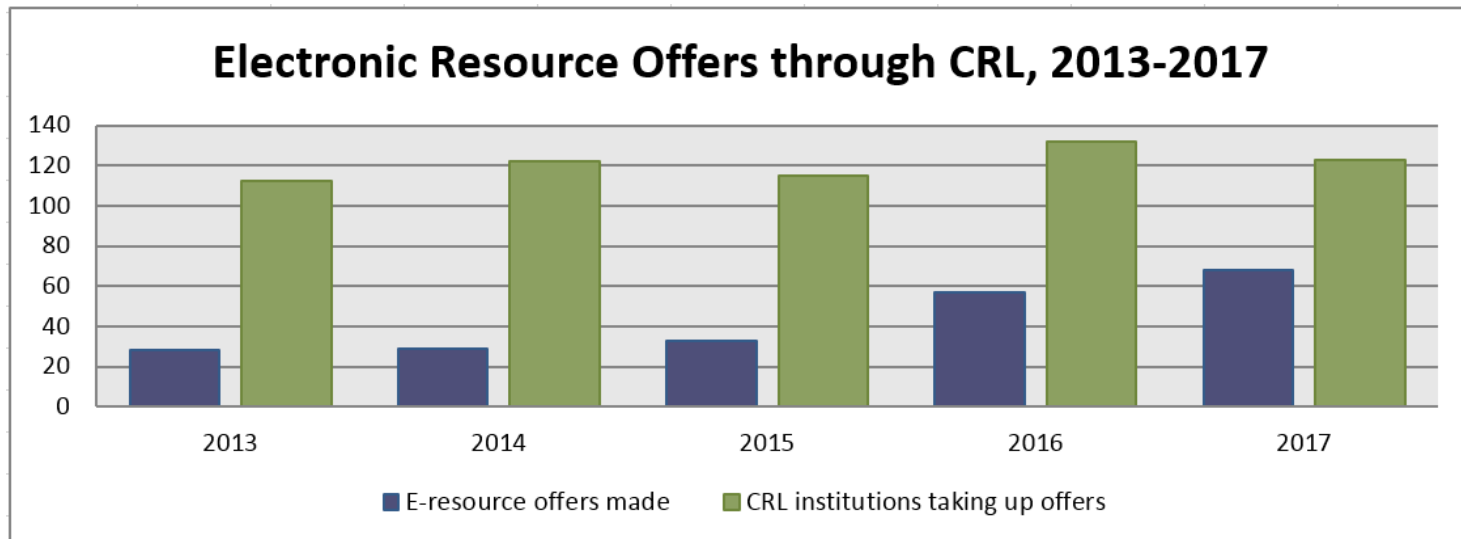

- Rates based on University enrollment (FTE)
- Existing contracts eligible for CRL rates on renewal
